If you are likely to gain at least **5 GCSEs at Grade 4 or above** (including some 9, 8, 7, 6, 5 grades and including Maths or English at grade 4 or higher), then you should consider **Level 3 courses (A level or equivalent)**.

Students taking Level 3 courses should pick 3 subjects from the selections below.

Foundation pathway – If your current grades indicate you are likely to get less than 5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above, you will may need a foundation year before moving onto a Level 3 package, you will follow a level 2 package.

English and Maths resit lessons are compulsory for students, in any sixth form, who achieve less than a grade 4 in either subject at the end of Year 11.

In addition, all students in our Sixth Form follow a certified programme in General RE.
