Where Creativity Matters

Performing Arts is a passion at St Mary's. We have many alumni who have gone on to have huge success in theatre, dance and drama. We are also part of the HFCMAT Creativity Collaborative which is one of only 8 across the country.

The Creativity Collaborative Programme, in conjunction with the Arts Council, aims to build networks of schools that will have a range of innovative teaching methods that help children and young people to develop their creative capabilities and enhance their lives.

Students perform each year at the Floral Pavilion Theatre for a variety of events. This is the first platform of many for our talented students. We are passionate about the arts and the way that they can energise lives and communities.

The various activities are in themselves a celebration of how the Arts and our students have made a significant and positive contribution to the school and the wider community.

Music

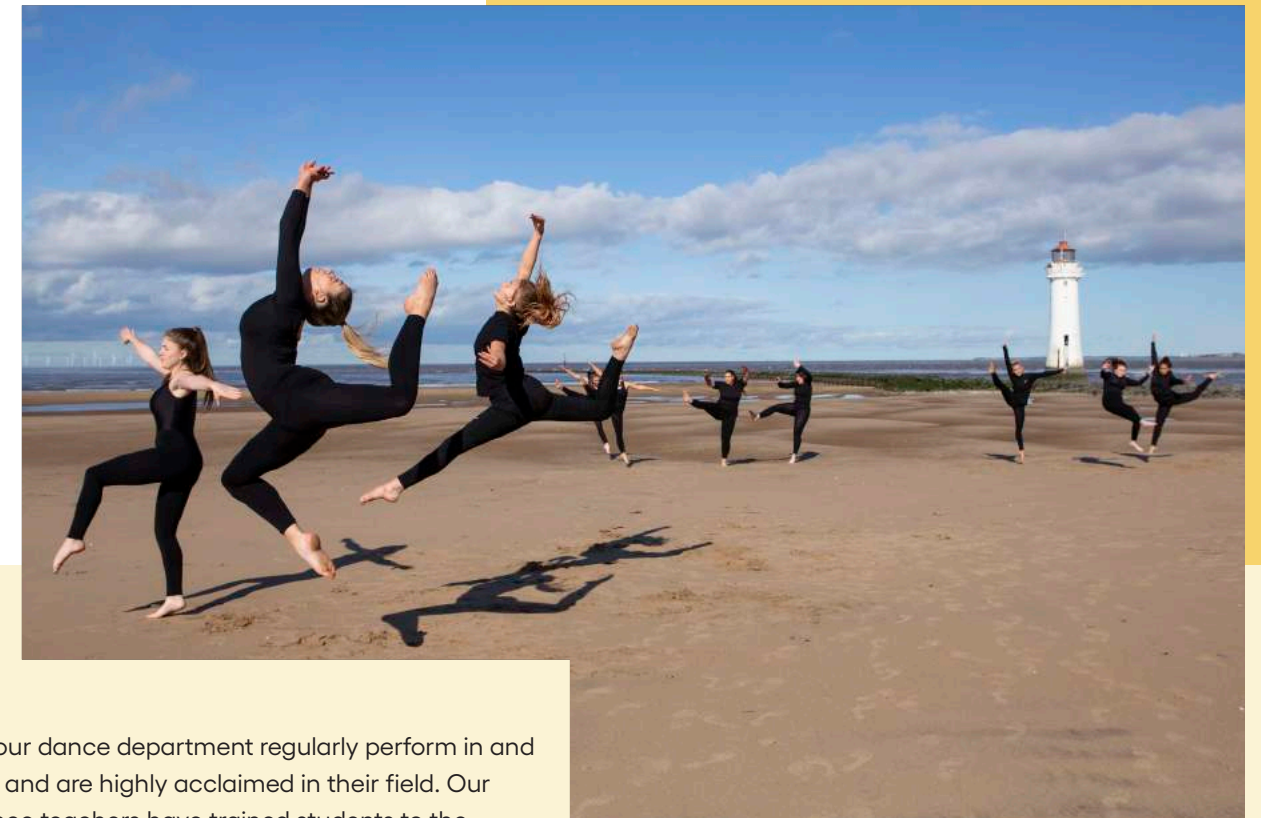
Music is important to us as a College. Students perform across the year, both as part of regular shows and concerts as well as to support our active liturgical calendar and performances each year.
