

Subject	Homework
Art	Homework is set as an ongoing contextual research project - found on Google classroom to deepen the understanding and knowledge of the artist studied during the unit and support practical work. Pupils will explore their own opinions and analyse art through ongoing research and quizzes.
D.T	Every three lessons through Google Classroom.
English	Homework is two hours of reading each two weeks and is set and checked fortnightly at reading lessons. Pupils should bring their signed, updated booklet to each reading lesson to show that they have been reading.
Food	Every three lessons through Google Classroom.
French	Homework set fortnightly WEEK A on Google Classroom - usually on SENECA or Quizlet for revision. It covers the vocabulary necessary to make progress in the half term topic. WEEK B a vocabulary sheet will be handed over to be memorised at home.
Geography	Set each week through Google Classroom Usually a reading or comprehension task to further deepen/ widen knowledge. A Seneca Learning assignment will be set each week which can be accessed via the Google Classroom and through parent's signing up to a parental account.
History	Homework will be set at least fortnightly, via Google Classroom. Seneca revision tasks will be set to consolidate learning. Tasks may be given on paper to enhance knowledge of the topic of study and to enable students to practice historical skills e.g. Source analysis.
ICT/Computing	Homework will be set 3 times per Unit of Work, all homework will be set on Google Classroom. First two homeworks will be set as a Google Form or using other online tools such as Kahoot!. The homework is accessible on a wide variety of devices including mobile phones. The forms will be set up to provide the students with some immediate feedback. The final homework will be a revision homework and will include a knowledge organiser as a revision aid.
Maths	Homework will be set weekly on a Thursday on www.sparxmaths.com, and is due at 3pm on Tuesday. Details of how to login are available on Google Classroom and at the back of all exercise books.
R.E	Weekly or fortnightly depending on the task and set on Google Classroom.
Science	Homework will be set via Google classroom with paper copies also available. For each unit of work students will have a key word definition homework, quiz homework and extended writing or comprehension homework.
P.E	Students informed to further their knowledge and understanding through watching videos linked to develop their subject knowledge on the skills of games we are due to learn in P.E lessons. Students also encouraged to attend extracurricular sessions at Lunchtimes and after school to further develop their subject knowledge and address misconceptions on knowledge
