



# YEAR 13 HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS

<b>ART</b>	Homework is weekly and set through Google Classroom. Practical homework requires students to either work on a continuous piece of artwork independently or create Artist pages.
<b>BUSINESS</b>	Homework will be set weekly. This will take a variety of forms depending on the unit that the student is working on, it could be coursework completion, preparation for set tasks or revision for an exam.
<b>CHILDCARE</b>	Set fortnightly or more frequently, for each unit / topic taught. Instructions and worksheets are given in class if applicable but it is always set on Google Classroom as well.
<b>DANCE</b>	Homework can be practical work - asking students to come to the studio either in lunch, after school or to practice at home. Or written, set on Google Classroom and have a link to the theory of dance.
<b>DRAMA</b>	Set weekly with instructions are on Google Classroom and paper copies if required. When Practical-based, it may require students to either learn lines independently or attend a group rehearsal. Occasionally, revision or coursework tasks will also be set.
<b>DT</b>	Set weekly in the form of revision tasks or coursework assignment write-ups. Instructions are given in lesson and all homework is set on Google Classroom. All support material and teacher presentations are available for students.
<b>ENGLISH</b>	Homework is set weekly and will include research, reading preparation, notes to contribute to group tasks/discussions and extended writing in response to exam style questions.
<b>FOOD</b>	Set weekly in the form of revision tasks or coursework assignment write-ups. Instructions are given in lesson and all homework is set on Google Classroom. All support material and teacher presentations are available for students.
<b>FRENCH</b>	Homework set on Google Classroom - usually a Quizlet for vocab learning as well as grammar and other topic based assessed language skills. One essay per cycle is also set.
<b>GEOGRAPHY</b>	Once a week, students will complete directed reading to prepare for the next lesson. Some homework will follow a flipped-learning model, prompting discussion in class; others will require applying knowledge (e.g. exam-style questions) to show understanding. Additional resources—webinars, revision sessions, and further reading—will be shared via Google Classroom. Students are also expected to work on their Independent Investigation, meeting milestone checkpoints to ensure they submit on time.
<b>HEALTH &amp; SOCIAL CARE</b>	Set fortnightly and normally comes in the form of revision, research, practice tasks or coursework assignment write-ups. Instructions are given in lesson and all Homework is set on Google Classroom alongside any relevant support materials.





# YEAR 13 HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS

<b>HISTORY</b>	Homework will be set weekly, via Google Classroom. Paper copies will also be available. The tasks will take the form of either reading, structured research to prepare pupils for future lessons or set A Level style questions designed to extend pupil knowledge and give additional practice for their final examinations. Self-revision will be expected as standard.
<b>ICT &amp; COMPUTING</b>	Homework will be set weekly. This will take a variety of forms depending on the unit that the student is working on, it could be coursework completion, preparation for set tasks or revision for an exam.
<b>MATHS</b>	Students will receive a past paper fortnightly to complete. In the first week students will be expected to complete this past paper. In the second week a youtube walkthrough of the paper will be available on Google Classroom, using this students will mark and correct their previous weeks work.
<b>MEDIA</b>	Set once a fortnight, with instructions being set on Google Classroom. Tasks will vary from exam style questions to completion of Classroom based or coursework tasks.
<b>MUSIC</b>	Set once a fortnight, with instructions being set on Google Classroom. Tasks will vary from exam style questions to completion of Classroom based or coursework tasks.
<b>PSYCHOLOGY</b>	Homework is set at least once per fortnight on Google Classroom, for each topic taught. It takes a range of forms including revision and answering exam style questions.
<b>RE</b>	Weekly, set on Google Classroom all students will have a revision folder & booklets and homework to match this.
<b>SCIENCE</b>	Approximately 2 hours of homework set each week in each subject - this will be specific to the subject but will most likely include the following; exam practice, self assessment and reflection, practical write up, research or flipped learning and evidence of revision techniques.
<b>SOCIOLOGY</b>	Homework is set at least once per fortnight on Google Classroom, for each topic taught. It takes a range of forms including revision and answering exam style questions.
<b>PE</b>	Homework is set at least weekly based on the assessment plan. The Everlearner platform is also used to complete differentiated tasks based on individual gaps in learning. Students will also have the opportunity to use this platform for personalised revision, through watching videos and completing exam style questions. Students will also use Google Classroom to continue working on assignments according to the assessment plan.
