YEAR 9 HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS

ART	Homework is set as a ongoing contextual research project found on google classroom to deepen the understanding and knowledge on Artist studied during the unit and support practical work - pupils will explore their own opinions and analyse Art through ongoing research and quizzes.
DT	A homework task will be set every three lessons through Google Classroom.
ENGLISH	Homework consists of two hours of reading every fortnight and is assigned and assessed during reading lessons. Students must bring their signed, up-to-date reading booklet to each lesson as proof of completion.
FOOD	A homework task will be set every three lessons through Google Classroom.
FRENCH	Homework set fortnightly WEEK A on Google Classroom - usually on SENECA or Quizlet for revision. It covers the vocabulary necessary to make progress in the half term topic. WEEK B a vocabulary sheet will be distributed to be memorised at home.
GEOGRAPHY	Homework will be set each week through Google Classroom. This will usually be a Seneca Learning assignment to consolidate learning. Seneca can also be accessed through parent's signing up to a parental account.
HISTORY	Homework will be set each week through Google Classroom. This will usually be a Seneca Learning assignment to consolidate learning. Seneca can also be accessed through parent's signing up to a parental account.
ICT	Homework will be set 3 times per unit of work, via Google Classroom. The first two homework will be set as a Google Form or using other online tools such as Kahoot!. The homework is accessible on a wide variety of devices including mobile phones. The forms will be set up to provide the students with some immediate feedback. The final homework will be a revision homework and will include a knowledge organiser as a revision aid.
MATHS	Homework will be set weekly on a Thursday on www.sparxmaths.com, and is due at 3.30pm on Tuesday. Details of how to login are available on Google Classroom and at the back of all exercise books.
RE	Weekly or fortnightly depending on the task and set on Google Classroom.
SCIENCE	Students will complete 4 daily goals through their homework platform Tassomai. This will be checked by their class teacher during a lesson each week which will be confirmed via Google classroom. Guardians will receive a weekly update from Tassomai on their child's progress.
PE	Students are encouraged to deepen their understanding by watching linked instructional videos that support the game skills covered in PE lessons. They are also invited to attend extracurricular sessions at lunch or after school to reinforce their learning and correct any misconceptions.
