



YEAR 11 HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS

ART	Set weekly on Google Classroom. Practical homework requires pupils to either work on a continuous piece of artwork independently or create Artist pages and to collect primary research in the form of photographs from home in relation to their personal project. Pupils are expected to attend intervention and complete all tasks set and respond to feedback during lessons independently.
BUSINESS	Weekly 30 min - set on Seneca. Revision and closing gaps activities always available on Google Classroom. Use the revision workbook to make revision notes or flash cards and complete the activities at the end of each topic.
CHILDCARE	Set fortnightly on Google Classroom. All resources and information are available on Google Classroom to support pupils for coursework. Resources are set for exam units on Google Classroom. Pupils also have a paper based Revision guide. Once exam content is started pupils are expected to complete revision materials at the end of each topic to accompany exam based questions set by the class teacher.
COMPUTING	Weekly 40 min - set on Google Classroom. Revision and closing gaps activities always available on Google Classroom. Pupils have access to a revision guide which they can read and made notes / flash cards from Use the pocket revision posters to create visual revision notes. Practice Python programming on activities set on Google Classroom.
DANCE	Set weekly on Google Classroom. Activities set to support intervention and completion of key components. Pupils are expected to attend intervention and extra rehearsals when needed. They will be given C3 exam booklets and written logs to complete.
DRAMA	Set weekly on Google Classroom. Activities set to support intervention and completion of key components. Pupils are expected to attend intervention and extra rehearsals when needed. They will be given C3 exam booklets and written logs to complete.
DT	Weekly - 30 minutes - Set on google classrooms, paper based also provided. Revision, support materials and activities always available on Google Classroom. Pupils are expected to work through their revision book and answer corresponding topic questions.
ENGLISH	Weekly 40 min: Alternated between paper based and Seneca. Revision and closing gaps always available on Google Classroom and Seneca. Pupils are expected to complete independent revision tasks with guidance and resources provided by their teacher. Written work will be completed in their unit of work booklets.
ENGINEERING	Weekly - 30 minutes - Set on google classrooms, paper based also provided. Revision, support materials and activities always available on Google Classroom. Pupils are expected to work through revision materials and answer corresponding topic questions.
FRENCH	Weekly 40 min Speaking and paper based / stuck at end of book. Revision and closing gaps activities always available on Google Classroom. Constantly revisit speaking booklets to keep a secure knowledge of topics studied over the two years. Use flashcards to test yourself and re-use in writing activities.
GEOGRAPHY	Weekly revision activities on paper (up to 1 hour) and 10-20 minute Seneca Assignment a week. Class resources on Google Classroom. BBC Bitesize, Seneca Learning and Personal Learning Checklists for each unit. There are also Knowledge organisers, videos, past exam questions. Pupils are expected to complete the active revision activities which are set each week as homework. These will be tested on a fortnightly basis using multiple choice questions and intervention offered to close any gaps in knowledge. There will also be a Seneca Learning assignment set each week to compound and support student learning. Pupils are expected to use the Personal Learning checklists in their class books to revise areas they feel less confident on.





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HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE	Set fortnightly on Google Classroom. All resources and information are available on Google Classroom to support pupils for coursework. Resources are set for exam units on Google Classroom. Pupils also have a paper based Revision guide. Once exam content is started pupils are expected to complete revision materials at the end of each topic to accompany exam based questions set by the class teacher.
HISTORY	Set weekly on Google Classroom - Seneca tasks for revision and consolidation. Fortnightly paper based exam practice. Class resources on Google Classroom. BBC Bitesize, Seneca Learning and Personal Learning Checklists for each unit. There are also Knowledge organisers, videos, past exam questions. Pupils are expected to complete Seneca revision activities and revision activities provided by their teacher. Revision guides will be sent out ahead of Mock Examinations.
HOSPITALITY	Weekly - 30 minutes - Set on google classrooms, paper based also provided. Revision, support materials and activities always available on Google Classroom. Two pages of revision questions booklet completed weekly.
ICT	Weekly 40 min - set on Google Classroom. Revision and closing gaps activities always available on Google Classroom. Use the revision workbook to make revision notes or flash cards and complete the activities at the end of each topic.
MATHS	Weekly - 40 min paper based. Revision and closing gaps activities always available on Sparx and Google Classroom. Four pages from the revision workbook (handed out to all pupils before summer) completed and checked each week by the class teacher.
MEDIA	Set fortnightly on google classroom. This will need to be done either in their exercise books or on google classroom. The work set will support the learning in the classroom. This will be research based/written tasks or exam questions. Pupils are expected to attend intervention and complete all tasks set.
MUSIC	Set weekly on Google Classroom. Individual and group tasks set in class and on Google Classroom. These will include resources to support the completion of Component 2 and 3. Pupils are expected to complete Component 2 by the end of term 1. This means engaging in daily practice and video recording their progress as portfolio evidence. Pupils are expected to attend intervention and extra rehearsals when needed. They will be given C3 exam resources and written logs to complete.
PSYCHOLOGY	Set fortnightly on Google Classroom. Revision resources and links are provided on Google Classroom. Pupils are given exam questions both as homework and in class, they are given a paper revision guide and have revision work booklets to support them. Each week pupils will receive a practice Research Methods question to complete at home. Pupils are expected to complete revision resources after each topic is completed.
RE	Weekly - 40 min - paper based. Google classroom - lesson for missed learning and Homework. Revision break down sheets with weekly revision activity. Revision books.
SCIENCE	StudentWeekly - Tassomai daily and weekly goals 40 min - paper based exam questions. Revision and closing gaps activities always available on Seneca and Google Classroom. Four pages from the revision workbook (handed out to all pupils before summer) completed and checked each week by the class teacher
SPORT AND COACHING PRINCIPLES	Set fortnightly - two everlearner tasks. Revision and closing gaps activities are always available on Google Classroom and theeverlearner website. Pupils username is their school email address and password Password1!. Pupils are expected to work through their past paper booklet completing questions along with ensuring all internal assessments are up to date through attending P&A intervention.
